

Horizons East Riding School Policies

• Riding School Progression Policies:

- o **Lessons are to be used by riders with the intent to ride 1 or 2 times per week.** The lesson level sheet will clarify progress of a rider.
- o <u>The school does not offer lessons to infrequent riders.</u> This is for the safety of the students and horses, as well as the quality of staff and services.

Lesson and Package Policies:

- o All lessons are booked by appointment in the Lesson Binder by parent or coach. You may text or email your bookings to 925-899-4968 or horizons-east@showstables.com.
- The one-time special for new students (buy 2 get 1 free) can only be used ONCE. After that, riders must buy monthly packages.

ALL LESSONS ARE PREPAID THE FIRST OF THE MONTH AND EXPIRE AT THE END OF EACH MONTH

- Riders are given 3 rollover lessons within a calendar year. Rollover lessons must be used within the next week.
- If a medical ailment or injury prevents the rider from attending long-term, Horizons East will consider the circumstances on an individual basis.
- o Lessons are transferable, NOT REFUNDABLE
- o A \$20 Facilities Fee is due at the beginning of each month.
- There is a one-time registration fee of \$25 for all new students, \$50 per family. This fee is due at the time of sign up.

All students must sign the following documents:

- Release form,
- o Registration form,
- Policy form.

• Cancellation policy:

- o All lessons must be cancelled 24 hours prior to the start of the lesson.
- o Horizons East has the right to move or cancel a lesson within 24 hours prior to the start of the lesson
- Missed lessons will be charged as a lesson and deducted from your package.

Payment Policies:

- o A bank penalty will be charged on bounced checks
- Cash discount is only given on lesson packages
- o A standard service fee on credit cards will be charged

Safety Policies:

- Helmets are worn at all times when mounted.
- o Children are not to be left in the stables unattended
- Parents may leave the facility during class but must pick students up no later then 10 min after the conclusion of the lesson
- o Children must wait in the gazebo or the lounge for pick up
- o Closed-toe shoes only in the stable area
- No feeding of the animals without a coach present

• Attire

- o Full length pants must be worn when riding
- Long hair needs to be tied back
- No skinny-strapped tank tops
- o Gloves should be worn when riding
- o Items stored in the tack room closet (boots, helmets, and pants) are for loan during riding lessons
